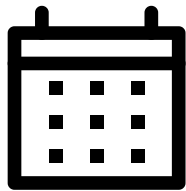
HANNAH'S TESTIMONY

I didn't know I was adopted until I was eight years old. My mom always told me that I could ask her anything and she would tell me the truth. I soon learned that my birth mother had planned to sell me. It was hard to hear, I believed it was my fault. I was hurt and angry. I treated my mom awful; we fought a lot because I was so angry.

When I attended CYIA this year, I heard the Amy Carmichael missionary story and how she rescued girls sold to be temple prostitutes. That stirred something in me. I began to understand just how much God loved me that he would send my mom to adopt me. My birth mother made a terrible choice, but it was her choice and had nothing to do with me. My CYIA cabin mates and leader prayed for me and helped me process my pain and anger. The next day, with God's help, I testified to the whole group, including my mom, what God had done in my heart. I am thankful for CYIA and my mom."

THE GREATEST NEED

As I watch the never-ending news cycle, it can feel overwhelming. I see news story after news story of children whose most basic needs - food, shelter, security - are not being met. I read article after article about children experiencing gender confusion, bullying, or record levels of anxiety. I personally have seen young people in my own home and church wrestle with suicidal thoughts, addiction, and hopelessness.

These problems are real, pressing, and not to be minimized, but the greatest need faced by children - or anyone, for that matter - is to know Jesus, the One who loves them eternally and perfectly, so that they might have a life characterized by the hope only Jesus can give. Saved children can experience the God-given promises in Hebrews 13 - He is always with them and He will help them do what's right. This is the heart of Good News Club - that lost children would move **from death to life** and saved children would grow in their blossoming relationship with the Lord.

This school year, **more than 50 children** have put their trust in Jesus as their Savior. It's children like Arthur* whose mom greeted me excitedly in the parking lot after he was saved in club that day and shared how much she had been praying for this very moment. It's children like Moses* who begged to come to Good News Club for months and on the very first day, saw his sister Erica* pray to receive Jesus. It's children like kindergarteners Austin* and Jordan* who have been soaking in the truth of the Gospel all school year and put their trust in Jesus just this past week.

In the words of Paul in Ephesians 1:16, "I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers." You are a vital part of CEF's ministry to children. Whether you are a volunteer or a donor or a prayer or a church partner, **it takes all of us to reach all of them.** Thank you for the work you do to help meet The Greatest Need.
